Below are step-by-step instructions on how to log into a Webex Event entitled “**Mock HTADME Event**”. (Please note: “**Mock HTADME Event**” is being used as an example, the links contained below **ARE NOT** links to the September 16-17 event.)

1. First you will receive an invitation directly from WebEx with the subject line: “**Invitation to Web seminar: Mock HTADME Event**” The contents will look like:

You will enter the registration password contained in the invitation email (in this case **123**) You will also need to enter your name, email address, and company affiliation. (Note: You must use the same email address you used to register for the event.)
